
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Bancroft Safe Parking Program in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the County of San Diego, located at 1600 Pacific Highway San Diego, CA 92101. The funding would be used to operate and maintain an overnight Safe Parking site for unhoused individuals living in their vehicles at a County-owned site in an unincorporated area of San Diego. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it provides a safe, legal, and accessible place for unhoused individuals to receive wraparound services that help them navigate towards permanent housing. In 2025, over half of the residents using Safe Parking sites transitioned to permanent housing.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1).
