I am requesting funding for the Spring Valley Community Center Upgrades in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the County of San Diego, located at 1600 Pacific Highway San Diego, CA 92101. The funding would be used to make upgrades and improvements to the Spring Valley Community Center. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will modernize the community center kitchen which provides senior congregate meals and food insecurity support. In 2025, the San Diego Hunger Coalition estimated that more than 1 in 4 older adults in San Diego County are nutrition insecure.
