Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Vision Zero Improvements in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of San Diego, located at 202 C Street, Floor 11, San Diego, CA 92101. The funding would be used to fund improvements across the City's most dangerous intersections to include installation of signalized intersections, accessible pedestrian signs, speed bumps, curb stripping, crosswalks, and medians. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would include pedestrian safety enhancements at the City's "Fatal 15" intersections – preidentified intersections with the highest rates of pedestrian and cyclist injuries or fatalities.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1) and 5305(a)(5).
