I am requesting funding for the Boulevard Drive Storm Drain Improvement Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of La Mesa, located at 8130 Allison Avenue, La Mesa, CA 91942. The funding would be used for the construction of a 200 foot-long storm drain box culvert and include community enhancements by constructing a parklet. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will mitigate further damages from floods that La Mesa experienced in January 2024, and provide much-needed green space for La Mesa residents.
