I am requesting funding for Reconfigurable Cyber Laboratory, Naval Base Point Loma in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Naval Base Point Loma, located at 140 Sylvester Road, San Diego, California 92106. The funding would be used to construct a reconfigurable computational and analysis cyber laboratory to enable offensive and defensive cyber teams to jointly test Command, Control, Communications, Computers and Intelligence Surveillance (C4I) systems in one location to support fleet missions, shore sites, and expeditionary forces. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the lab supports national defense readiness and consolidates capabilities to one site, which enhances efficiency for fleet missions and expeditions.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized by 10 U.S.C. Chapter 169.
