I am requesting funding for the San Miguel Fire Engine in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection District, located at 2850 Via Orange Way, Spring Valley, CA 91978. The funding would be used for one, type 1 fire engine that will replace an outdated fire apparatus. This new engine would service high-volume areas that depend upon timely responses from first responders. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve public safety and response times for a community with a high volume of calls, especially as fire season continues to grow in San Diego County.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
